

Travelling with the carte Explore

Clear instructions for journeys to Lausanne and Geneva (-Airport)

The **carte Explore** is valid only within specific **Mobilis zones**. Depending on your destination, you may need to purchase an **additional ticket** for part of the journey.

1. Travelling to **Lausanne** with the carte Explore

Card validity

The carte Explore is valid **up to Rolle (Mobilis zone)**.

 Travel between **Nyon and Rolle** is therefore free of charge.

Which ticket do you need?

To continue to **Lausanne**, you must purchase an **additional ticket from Allaman to Lausanne**.

 The train does not need to stop in Allaman – the ticket simply covers this section of the route.

Which trains can you use?

You may use **all trains between Nyon and Lausanne**, including:

- **RE services**
- **IR services**

2. Travelling to **Geneva (-Airport)** with the carte Explore

✓ Card validity

The carte Explore is valid **up to Mies**.

⚠ To benefit from the card up to this limit, you must take a **train that stops in Mies**.

👉 This requires a **change of trains in Coppet**.

Two possible options from Nyon

Option A – Faster (direct), but more expensive

- Travel on **RE33 services only**
- Purchase an **additional ticket from Coppet to Geneva**
- ⏰ Journey time: approx. **16 minutes**

Option B – Cheaper, but with one additional change

- Travel on **RE33 to Coppet**
- Change to **RL2 or RL4 services**
- Purchase an **additional ticket from Mies to Geneva**
- ⏰ Journey time: approx. **39 minutes**

⚠ Important: IR trains to Geneva

If you travel to Geneva using an **IR service**:

- ❌ the carte Explore **is not valid**
- 🚘 you must purchase a **full ticket from Nyon to Geneva**
