

LAUSANNE IN A NUTSHELL

A CENTRAL MEETING POINT IN EUROPE

Located only 45 minutes by car or train from the international airport in Geneva (Cointrin), Lausanne is centrally accessible via all of the main methods of transportation in Switzerland and Europe. Several trains leave for Lausanne every hour from all major Swiss cities, and even more remote areas benefit from easy connections. If you're headed to Paris or Milan, for example, there are three to eight high-speed trains a day to choose from, arriving in under four hours.

A PLAYGROUND OF NATURAL WONDERS

Lausanne is nestled against a breathtaking backdrop which includes Lake Geneva – the biggest lake in Western Europe – and the majestic beauty of the Alps. It also features the Lavaux wine region, a UNESCO world heritage site with grapevines that cascade down the hills to the very edge of the lake. And it's only ten minutes from the city.

THE HOME OF INTERNATIONAL SPORT

The history of the city and that of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) have been inextricably linked ever since the latter established its headquarters there in 1915. In 1993, the city opened the Olympic Museum, casting a unique spotlight on the sporting world. The following year, Lausanne was selected to be the Olympic Capital — a prestigious and unique label. Last but not least, in 2015,

the IOC celebrated its IOOth anniversary on the banks of Lake Geneva. The Committee's dedication and the support of national, regional and local authorities have made it possible to welcome the offices of over 5O international sporting federations and organisations in the greater Lausanne area. Lausanne is currently considered to be the world capital of sport administration.

UNPARALLELED QUALITY OF LIFE

Lausanne is committed to sustainable development since the 9Os. Local public services were therefore required to respect the environment and include nature in the city's development. In 1996, the municipality of Lausanne received the City of Energy award and was then ranked in the top tier amongst 6O competing municipalities in 2OOI. In 2OO4, Lausanne's energy policy earned it the very first European Energy Award Gold certification (confirmed in 2OO9). A similar approach was adopted by many private companies in order to reinforce Lausanne's reputation as a city that anticipates future challenges.

For a city of its size, it provides an impressive foothold for businesses, the arts, sport and education. Located in the French-speaking part of Switzerland, Lausanne is the country's fourth largest urban hub.

FORMALITIES REQUIRED FOR TRAVELLING TO SWITZERLAND

Each traveller must have a valid passport or ID card.

Switzerland is a member of the Schengen Area. Citizens of the European Union (EU) and the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) countries may enter Switzerland without a visa.

For nationals of countries outside the EU or EFTA, the requirements for entry into Switzerland depend on the traveller's nationality, as well as the purpose (tourism, visit, business, studies, etc.) and duration of his/her stay (shortor long-term). The website of the State Secretariat for Migration (SEM) will inform you whether or not you require a visa to enter Switzerland and on the travel documents that are recognised:

GETTING TO LAUSANNE

Lausanne is located in French-speaking western Switzerland on the shores of Lake Geneva. It is also the capital of the canton of Vaud.

The closest airport is the international airport in Geneva, which is 45 minutes away by train or car.

The train station, operating four trains per hour, is inside the airport.



LAUSANNE TRANSPORT CARD

Guests staying in the hotels located in the greater Lausanne area can travel throughout the public transportation network for free (bus and metro zones II, I2, I5, I6, I8 and I9) for the duration of their stay (max. I5 days). The Lausanne Transport Card is provided by the hotel at check-in and is valid for the full length of the reservation, including the date of departure. For the initial transfer to accommodation, guests simply need to present the hotel booking confirmation (first name, surname, date of arrival and departure of the guest/s must appear). The card also grants holders a number of discounts at businesses and tourist attractions across the city.

A JOURNEY BACK IN TIME AT CHÂTEAU **DE CHILLON™**

With its two façades, fortress on the mountainside and princely residence on the lake side, Chillon Castle $^{\text{TM}}$ is Switzerland's most visited historic building. Built on a rocky island, this magnificent landmark was restored at the end of the 19th century and visitors can explore the basement and castle dungeon. A much sought-after venue for events, it comprises a series of rooms which are available for hire, the largest of which has capacity for 300 people (230 seated).

LAVAUX VINEYARDS

GRUYÈRES: VISIT TO A CHEESE AND/OR CHOCOLATE FACTORY

Approximately 50 km from Lausanne, Gruyères is one of Switzerland's most attractive medieval cities. The town lends its name to the Fribourg Pre-Alps region as well as the famous cheese. Every year, visitors to the town are won over by its castle, boutiques, and charming hotels and restaurants, not to mention an unusual science-fiction museum dedicated to the Swiss artist Giger. Maison Cailler and the Maison du Gruyère are both just minutes from this iconic village.

Lausanne Convention Bureau (LCVB) helps regional, national and international event organisers looking to hold an event in the Lausanne region. To that end, LCVB provides a variety of services, some of which are free.

Free services provided by LCVB:

- Expert advisory, location scouting and feasibility analyses
- Support for the organisation of meetings and conventions
- Assistance regarding calls for tender and site visits
- Tourist information and promotional tools
- Contact information for key partners

If the project involves over I5O attendees, the organiser may choose to fully or partially delegate the organisation of the event to our team of professionals, which maintains regular contact with service providers in Lausanne.

1. ALL-IN-ONE PACKAGE

PRE-CONFERENCE PREP

- Creation of an online platform to manage conference registration, accommodation, recreational activities and transfers
- Follow-up on changes and cancellations
- Record-keeping and management of payments
- Confirmation for each participant (registration, hotel and payment)
- Provision of standard badges (lanyards available upon request)
- Preparation of personal documentation (invitations, vouchers, etc.)
- Administrative management and invoicing for the event location and direct service providers (optional)
- Networking Tool (activation not included, see section 6 below)

WELCOME AND LOGISTICS SERVICES DURING THE CONFERENCE

- Greeting of participants at the welcome desk throughout the entire event
- Distribution of personal documentation (conference packets)
- Last minute registrations and on-site payments
- Processing of any changes
- General and tourist information services
- Coordination of recreational activities and transfers

ACCREDITATION

- Development of an accreditation system
- On-site accreditation for attendees at the conference (with standard badges)

CLOSING OF THE CONFERENCE

- Certificates of participation in PDF format and online satisfaction survey sent to attendees (upon request at no additional fee)
- Account verification and finalisation
- Summary charts and tallies

NOTES

Opting for this service is essentially hiring an administrative body at LCVB which is fully committed to organising a specific event. Beyond outsourcing a great many logistical factors for the event, the main advantage for the organiser is considerable time savings.

The platform is available in French, German or English. A second language can be added for an additional fee.

2. ACCOMMODATION

ONLINE RESERVATION PLATFORM

- Creation of an online hotel reservation platform available in three languages (FR, DE, EN)
- Access to contingents of hotel rooms at current rates (yield management)
- Customisation of the platform (logo, contacts and links) to suit the event
- Creation of a personalised map indicating hotels, main locations and public transportation stops (Google Maps)
- Processing of each reservation
- Confirmations for each attendee and for the hotel
- Processing of changes/cancellations

2.2

ROOMING LIST (RL) MANAGEMENT

- Room searches
- Contingent reservations (released six weeks prior to the event or the time frame specified by the hotel)
- Creation of a model rooming list for the organiser, who fills it in
- Communication of rooming lists to hotels
- Processing of changes/cancellations

The organiser confirms each attendee's reservation.

NOTES

The hotel reservation platform is reserved for conference attendees. Attendees must have a credit card to guarantee the reservation. The card is only charged in the event of a cancellation or no-show. Cancellation is free up to a maximum of 72 hours before the check-in date.

Contingents of hotel rooms and prices established by hotel operators change on a daily basis without notice according to supply and demand.

The hotel reservation platform is available in three languages – French, German and English – unless you select the all-in-one package. The all-in-one package includes both platforms in only one language (French, German or English), with a second language available for an additional fee.

LCVB also provides a help desk via email and by phone for conference attendees with questions or specific hotel requests.

This service is included in the all-in-one package.

NOTES

LCVB can manage accommodation for specific groups such as organisational staff, speakers and sponsors. The organiser has to provide the exact dates, number of rooms and nights (per person), and all other details required to make the hotel reservations.

The hotel may require a deposit, for which the organiser shall be responsible. No reservation shall be confirmed without its corresponding payment.

This service is included in the all-in-one package.


8. RECEPTION OUTSIDE OF BUSINESS HOURS

- List of attendees present
- Post-event report on attendee traffic for each session
