WHERE ARE WE?



"FROM VINE TO GLACIER"

Discover our region – stretching from the Chablais plain to the summit of the Diablerets glacier at 3,210 metres above sea level. Start your visit over 4.6 kilometres lower down in the <u>Bex Salt Mines</u>. Then take a dip in the thermal baths at <u>Lavey-les-Bains</u>, Switzerland's hottest thermal spring. When you resurface, continue your journey through the vineyards of Bex and Ollon, the birthplace of authentic Cru wines created in soil with a unique terroir.





As you gain altitude, you'll notice the increasingly distinctive chalets of <u>Gryon</u>, a village bathed in the calming atmosphere of this traditional mountain setting. Just a few kilometres away, in <u>Villars</u>, old ancestral chalets stand alongside more recent constructions in wood and stone. Enjoy this modern resort from the vantage point of a natural, south-facing balcony. In summer, take the car or bus along the Col de la Croix road, which winds through an alpine landscape with traditions dating back centuries. Cross the pass and head for the authentic village of <u>Les Diablerets</u>, nestled beneath an imposing mountain range. Here, legends and traditional customs are combined with sporting pleasures and the joys of eternal snow thanks to <u>Glacier 3000</u>.





Villars-sur-Ollon

For over 150 years, the resort of Villars-sur-Ollon has offered its guests a wide variety of sporting and leisure activities.



Famous for its ski area linked to Gryon and Les Diablerets, Villars-sur-Ollon has facilities to suit all budgets, offering an abundance of sporting opportunities in the winter and summer seasons. Here you will find a host of recently renovated hotels and restaurants catering to all tastes. The understated luxury of this resort is perfectly encapsulated by the iconic Villars Palace hotel.

Villars offers extraordinary views of the neighbouring mountains, while its baths are the perfect place to relax and get away from it all. The Villars-Gryon-Diablerets-Bex ski area stretches over more than 130 km (including Glacier 3000) and can be reached via the rack railway from Villars station to Bretaye or with the Roc d'Orsay gondola. In summer, the 18-hole par 69 golf course at Golf Club Villars is a must. Below, the village of Ollon is nestled amongst the Chablais vineyards. A detour down the alleyways will reveal some very attractive historic buildings.

Set against some of the Alps' most beautiful peaks, such as the Muveran and the Miroir <u>d'Argentine</u> - an ancient fossilised coral reef 100 million years old - the village of <u>Gryon</u> exudes authenticity, with its traditional chalets dating back more than 800 years. The historic village is also officially protected. Accessible by train from Villars or Bex on the BVB line, this area is famous for skiing and hiking.

In summer, the Frience recreational area is a wonderful place to swim in a unique setting. And in winter, this area is transformed into a space for children to go tobogganing.

A must for keen walkers, the trails can be explored in both summer and winter. And for a real curiosity, pay a visit to the hamlet of Taveyanne. Classified as a national historical heritage site and nature reserve since 1970, it owes its uniqueness to its traditional chalets with "tavillon" wooden shingle roofs dating back to the 16th century, and to the beauty of its pastures.

Les Diablerets

Situated in the heart of the Vaud Alps at 1,200 metres above sea level, the village of <u>Les Diablerets</u> is an authentic resort at the foot of a majestic mountain range. Made up almost entirely of chalets, the village has managed to keep the spirit of a bygone era alive. With its countless waterfalls and mountain lakes, its hiking routes and its biking trails, the region has a wealth of experiences to discover. Its ski area is an integral part of the wider Villars-Gryon-Les Diablerets ski area.

One of the longest sledging runs in Switzerland, with over 7 km of track, is laid out in winter from 'Les Mazots', at the top of the Diablerets Express (top of the gondola lift). Plenty of laughter is guaranteed here in a relaxed atmosphere. Another of the resort's unique features is a <u>night-time cross-country skiing track</u> under solar-powered lights, so you can enjoy this sport while nature is slumbering peacefully every evening from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. in winter! A centre for culture and tradition, the <u>Musée des Ormonts</u> also offers a variety of exhibitions on different aspects of valley life throughout the year.

In the summer, <u>Lac Retaud</u> offers enchanting scenery, and even swimming opportunities for the truly adventurous! Nature lovers and thrill seekers alike can enjoy an endless playground in Les Diablerets. Here, right on the doorstep of Glacier 3000, you can try paragliding or take on the via ferrata, or even have a go on an all-terrain scooter

The <u>Peak Walk by Tissot</u>, the world's only suspension bridge linking two summits, offers a majestic view of the Alps that takes in highlights such as the Matterhorn, Mont Blanc, the Eiger, the Mönch and the Jungfrau. 108 metres long and just 80 centimetres wide, this bridge offers an experience like no other and attracts visitors from all over the world. <u>The Glacier 3000 ski area</u> is open from November to May and is home to one of the steepest ski runs in the world, the Black Wall, with a gradient of 46 degrees!

In summer and winter alike, the <u>Glacier Walk</u> offers a unique opportunity to take a walk along a secured trail to the station at Scex Rouge. In just one hour you will reach the Quille du Diable peak, with its stunning panoramic view over the valley of Derborence. The Refuge de l'Espace restaurant and its terrace are also very popular with locals.

For the thrill seekers among us, the <u>Alpine Coaster</u> features dozens of twists and turns at speeds of up to 40km/h. Quite simply, it's the highest rail toboggan run in the world! From <u>dogsled rides</u> to the <u>Snow Bus</u>, Glacier 3000 has plenty of euphoric experiences to delight its visitors.

Bex





From the 19th century to the first half of the 20th century, **Bex** was a major tourist hub. Its baths and grand hotels drew visitors in their droves.

Deep under the ground, "white gold" was discovered here in as early as the 15th century. For a long time, salt was the economic lifeblood of the entire region. Although still in operation, the <u>Salt Mines</u> and their 52 kilometres of underground galleries are now also a popular tourist attraction. The commune of Bex covers a vast and varied landscape, with <u>numerous vineyards</u> where you can taste exceptional wines. To round off a day on the plains, the axe-throwing activity at Axers offers a truly unique experience.

Further up the mountain is Pont de Nant, above Les Plans-sur-Bex. Its alpine garden, <u>La Thomasia</u>, is one of the cantonal botanical gardens and is home to some 3,000 alpine plants. Rising from the valley floor is the famous Miroir d'Argentine, overlooking the <u>Solalex</u> pasture. This limestone plateau offers endless climbing routes right up to its summit at 2,422 metres above sea level! Traditional cuisine is served in the surrounding mountain lodges, where hearty and delicious fare is always guaranteed. Nature is still unspoilt here, making it ideal for climbing, hiking and cross-country skiing.



The thermal spa of <u>Lavey-les-Bains</u> is located on the plain, a few kilometres from Bex. Several outdoor pools, including one spanning more than 1,000 m2, will leave you with a sense of well-being all year round.

At the foot of the slopes, the Bains de Villars provides an opportunity for some well-deserved relaxation in summer or winter. With its heated outdoor pool, saunas, steam rooms and relaxation rooms, this oasis of well-being makes the view of the Dents du Midi all the more breathtaking!

Several hotels in the area offer access to spas and wellness areas for the general public. These include the Chalet **RoyAlp** & Spa, Villars Palace and Les Mazots du Clos.

For an original and rejuvenating treat, the **Riversong** experience, with water heated over a wood fire in an authentic larch barrel, is well worth the trip!

The area has two wine-growing communes, Ollon and Bex, with south-facing slopes. The hot, dry climate and the high gypsum content of the soil give the wine its distinctive classic character. Chasselas, Pinot Noir and Gamay make up the majority of wine production here, but there are also specialities such as Garanoir, Gamaret, Sylvaner and Viognier, as well as rosés and sparkling wines. Some of the wines from these communes have even won awards at international competitions.

<u>Bitter des Diablerets</u>, the signature drink of Les Diablerets, is a bitter aperitif made from gentian, orange peel and various plants and roots. Created in 1876, legend has it that this drink was invented following a landslide caused by the devil, who lived on the glacier. Many of the local inhabitants perished, while others survived by eating the roots of various plants.

Craft breweries : The region is home to a number of craft breweries, some of which have won prizes in official beer competitions. These include, for example, the Brasserie La Mine in Bex or the Brasserie des Diablerets.









A DESTINATION STEEPED IN CULTURE AND TRADITION



<u>Château de la Roche</u>, Ollon: A fortified house dating back to the 13th century, now fully renovated and a venue for shows, exhibitions and conferences.

<u>Musée des Ormonts</u>: A museum located in the idyllic village of Vers-L'Eglise (next to Les Diablerets), housing temporary exhibitions on various themes relating to the history and culture of Les Diablerets.

LThe village of **Gryon** was the setting for Marc **Voltenauer's crime** novel, 'Le Dragon du Muveran'.

The town of **Bex** is known as "the city of salt and water" because of the Bex **Salt Mines**. It is also famous for its botanical garden, La Thomasia, which is situated in the Vallon de Nant and protected by the conservation organisation Pro Natura. La Thomasia is home to more than 3,000 mountain plants, covering a geographical range from the Alps to the Himalayas, via the Andes and the Rockies.

The five international colleges of Villars and their 700 students enjoy a long-standing reputation dating back to the beginning of the 20th century, making the resort a prime location for the high-quality education of countless students from a wide range of backgrounds.

Built in the 19th century, the <u>Les Planches sawmill</u> is an exceptional testament to the hydraulic installations of the Les Diablerets region. The sawmill was recently brought back to life and is now open to the public for tours.
