



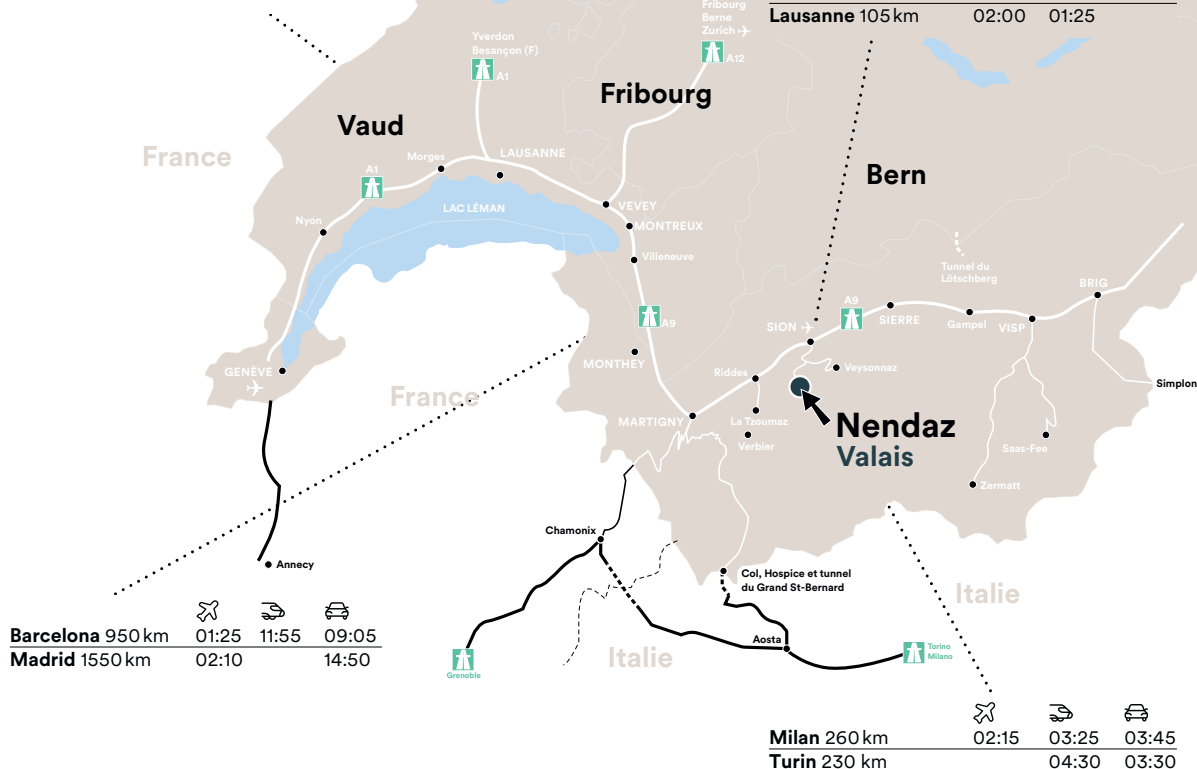

### Boutique Hôtel Nînda NEW

Opening in the winter of 2026, this new boutique hotel is set in the heart of the Clèves hamlet in Haute-Nendaz. The Boutique Hôtel Nînda boasts 11 rooms, all fully equipped with kitchenettes, and can sleep up to 26 guests. There are garden-level rooms, duplexes and traditional wooden chalets (mazots), including a family mazot that can accommodate up to six people. With 12 double beds and two single beds, the Boutique Hôtel Nînda is perfect for couples, families or

groups of friends. In addition to its comfortable rooms, the Boutique Hôtel Nînda offers a Mountain Coffee Shop, yoga classes, a tailor-made workshop and retreat programme, and a dog walking service.

## UNIQUE FEATURES OF THE DESTINATION

However, many overnight stays also take place in holiday homes, either by their owners who are very loyal to Nendaz, or by weekly or seasonal guests.

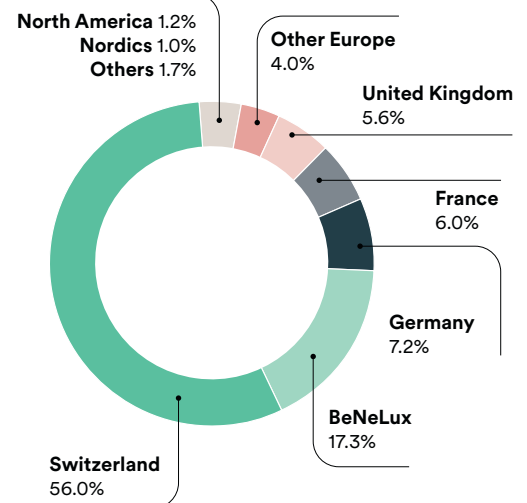

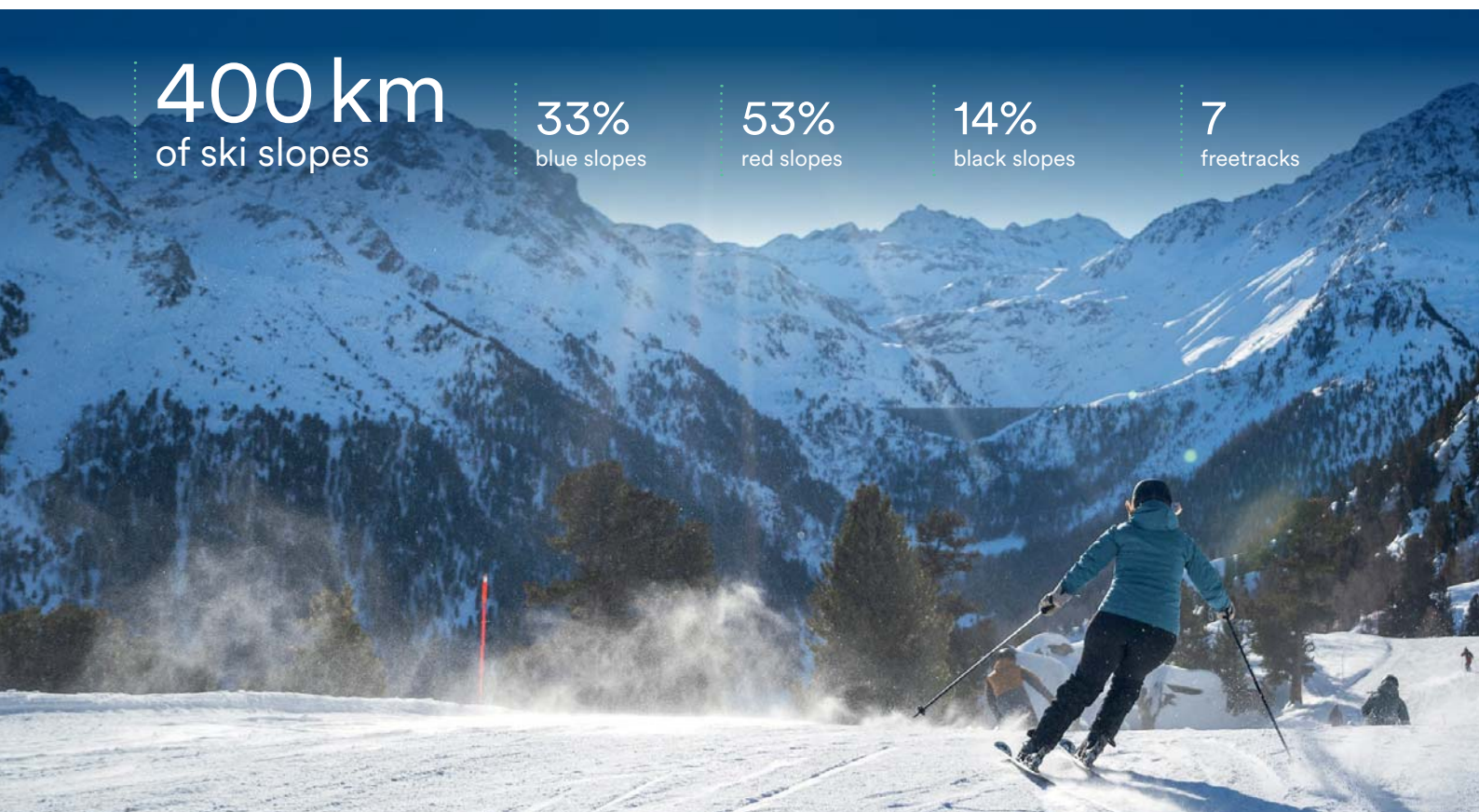

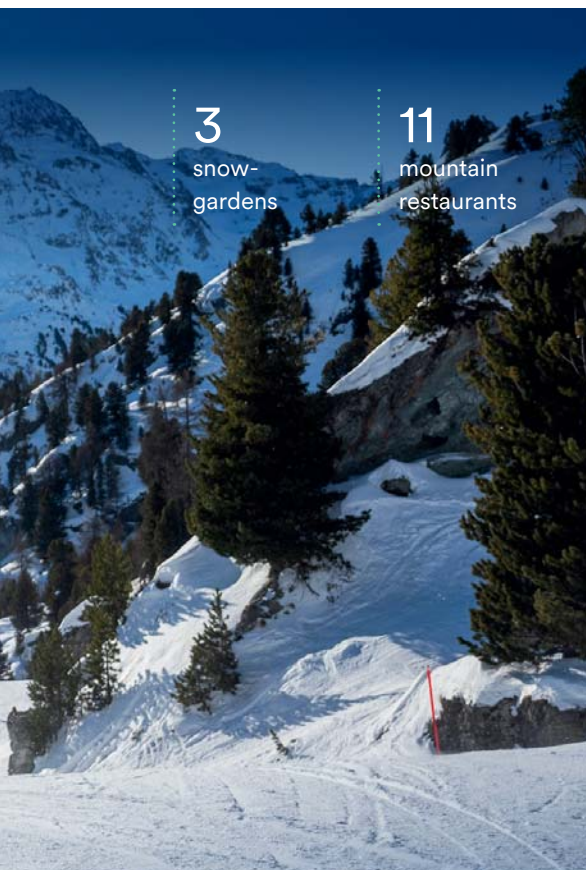

## The Mont-Fort experience

Mont-Fort boasts a panoramic view of ten of the most beautiful and iconic peaks in the Alps, including the Matterhorn, Mont Blanc, Grand Combin and Dent Blanche. The highest point in the 4 Vallées ski resort, it rises to 3,330 metres above sea level and is easily accessible to skiers and non-skiers alike via the ski lifts.

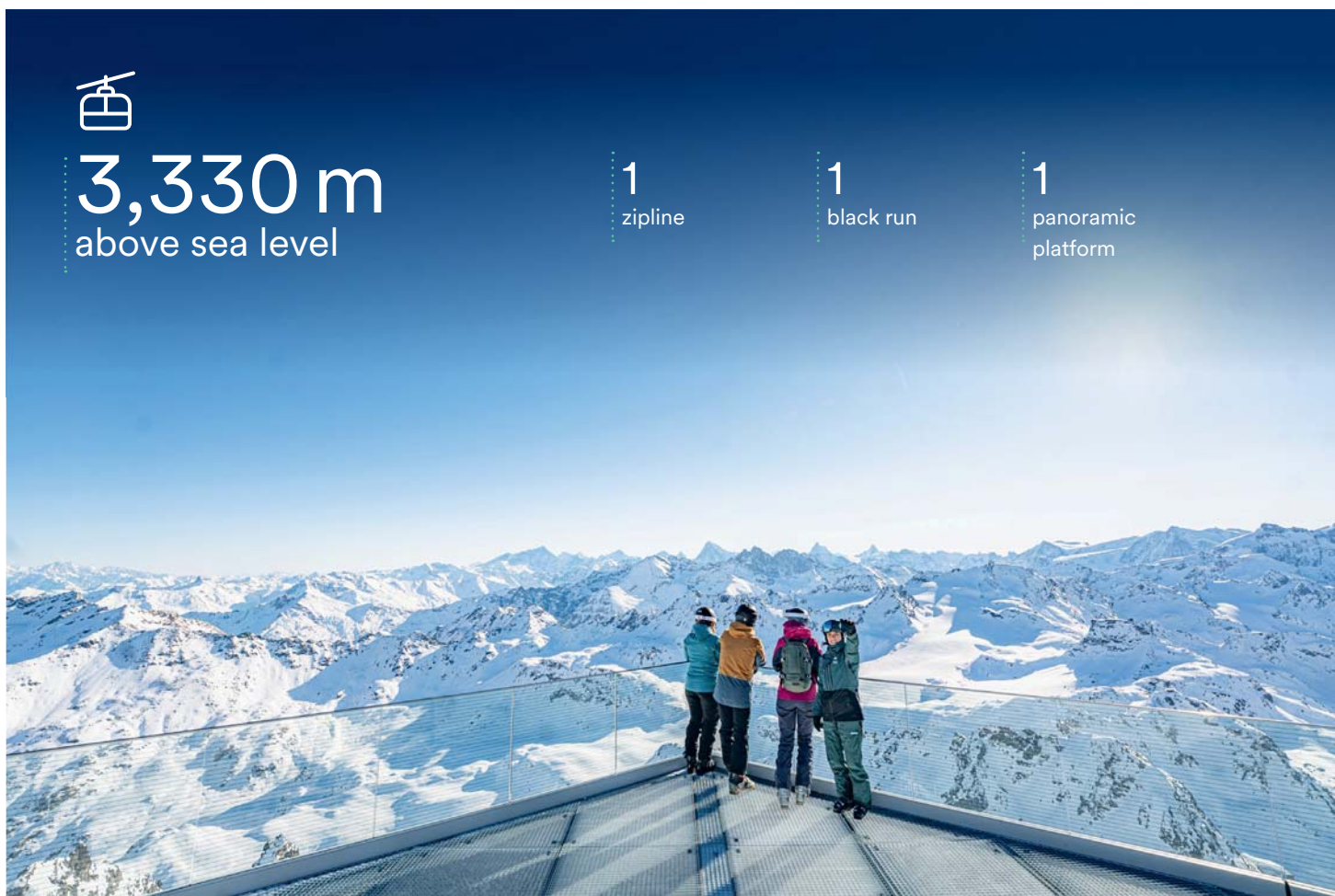

Easily accessible by ski lift, it allows both skiers and non-skiers to enjoy the stunning 360-degree view in complete safety.





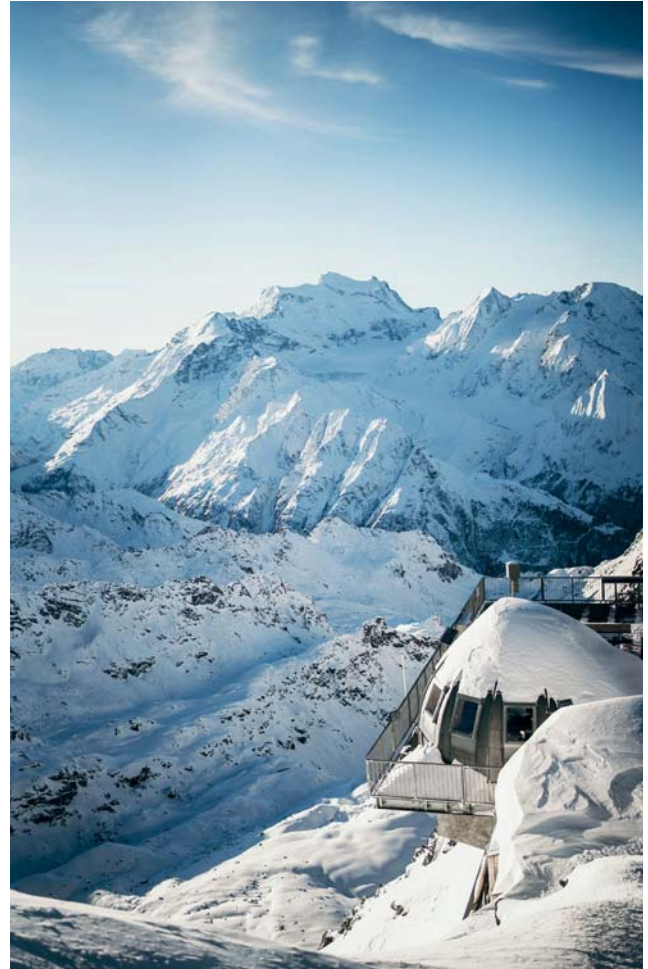


### **Black run over 40°**

The Mont-Fort ski slope is known to be one of the steepest in the Alps. It is, in fact, so steep that it is impossible to groom. It is, however, marked and secure. Reserved for experienced skiers.

### **The highest zipline in the world**

With a top speed of over 100 km/h, a length of 1.4 km and a difference in altitude of 323m, it challenges the bravest of enthusiasts as they soar from the summit of Mont-Fort at 3,330m above sea level towards Les Gentianes, flying at full speed over the Tortin glacier.



### **Igloo Bar**

From Europe's highest Igloo Bar, guests can enjoy an incredible view over the Alps while enjoying a snack, a cheese fondue or a Swiss Rock Café, the house speciality made with espresso, Abricotine liqueur, cane sugar and whipped cream.

Hanging from a cable  
at 3,330 metres above sea level

**It's in the gondola to Mont-Fort that I fully realise what awaits me: I'll follow the same path as the gondola, but suspended from a single cable!**

My adventure begins in Siviez, which can be reached by car or by bus. From there, I take no less than three ski lifts to reach the Mont-Fort zipline at 3,330 meters above sea level, the highest in the world and the longest in the Alps! Over 1.4 km long and with a top speed of over 100km/h, this attraction promises to be quite a thrilling experience.

At Gentianes, it's time to gear up before continuing up the mountain. I am asked to get on the scales. Fortunately, the indiscreet machine does not display the kilos — just four sizes marked S, M, L, XL. For me, the needle stops between the M and the L. I'm given the choice: fast descent or a little slower?

Since I'm already here, I might as well choose the faster option, as long as it's safe. So I'm geared up with the smaller size. The material is pretty substantial, like

what's needed for the zip lines in adventure parks, my only reference until now. But then I wouldn't want less to fly over an entire glacier.

It's in the gondola to Mont-Fort that I fully realise what awaits me: I'll follow the same path as the gondola, but suspended from a single cable! The drop

of 383 meters that I had read about on the website suddenly becomes very real. I take a few minutes to admire the panoramic view, which alone is worth the trip, with legendary summits such as the Matterhorn and the Mont-Blanc in sight. On the launch platform, the excitement begins to build and the adrenaline starts to flow. The descent suddenly seems steep and the landing platform far away. In no time at all, I am sitting in the void and the countdown is on. 3... 2... 1... GO! First comes a surge of adrenaline due to the incredible acceleration. Then comes an incredible sense of freedom and serenity — I'm flying solo between sky and ice. I spread my arms and let myself be swept along. The landing is soft, applauded by some hikers marveling at this unusual “bird” touching down.

A few words of advice: dress warmly in all seasons. The temperature difference between the car park in Siviez and Mont-Fort is considerable. Don't forget to wear sunglasses to protect against the wind, as well as gloves and a warm hat!

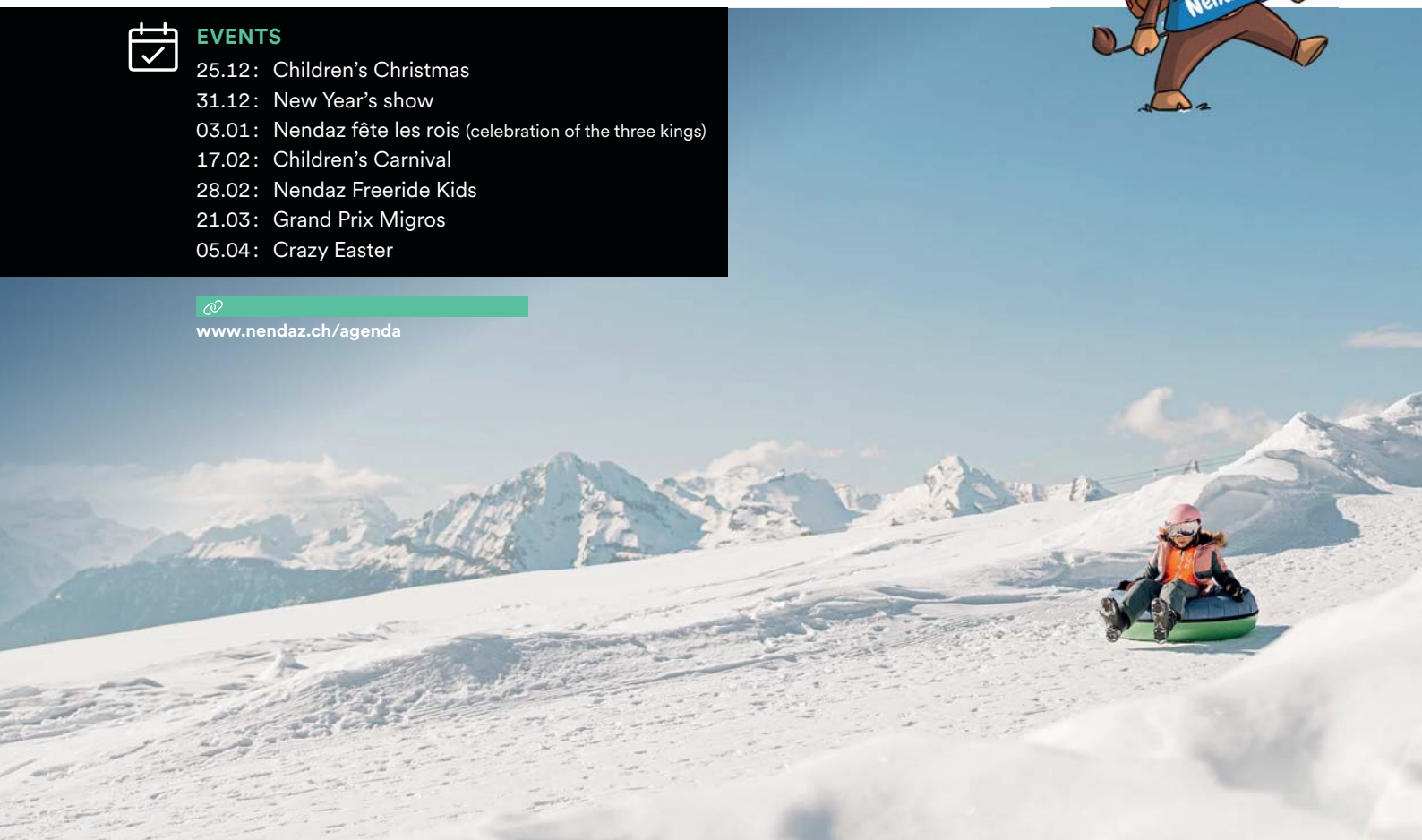

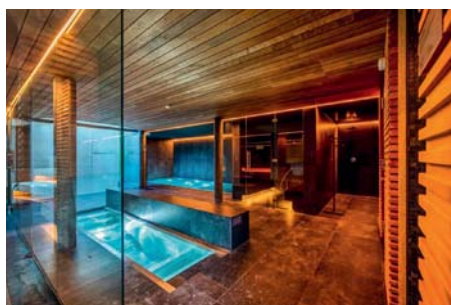

In a contemporary alpine setting, the Spa des Bisses is an invitation to re-charge your batteries in a space of 2'200 m<sup>2</sup>. Designed on two levels, this area dedicated to water is reminiscent of the natural environment of the region, with a bisse running through the middle of it. It offers everything you need to enjoy a moment of relaxation: outdoor pool, sauna, jacuzzi, steam bath, salt grotto, ice grotto, Kneipp course, children's area, floating pool, against the current swimming pool, fitness centre, treatment rooms and two private spas with sauna, steam room, jacuzzi and private winter garden. The Spa des Bisses is located in the Nendaz 4 Vallées \*\*\*\* Hotel and is also open to the public.

## The MAD Mount Hotel

As well as being ideally located at the foot of the ski slopes, the MAD Mount offers an all-round experience with a re-energizing spa, restaurant and bar with terrace to ensure guests have the best possible experience. What's more, the hotel is committed to sustainability, and is proud to be one of the first carbon-negative hotels in Switzerland.

## MAD Retreat

## A snowshoe-raclette evening







We feel as if we are going against the flow when we arrive in Siviez at 5 pm. The car park, which has been bustling with activity all day, is now deserted. Here we are, 4 friends at the foot of the slopes at the time when most holidaymakers are enjoying their mulled wine by the fire.

Our guide, Anita, welcomes us with a broad smile, snowshoes already on her feet and 4 pairs ready and waiting for us. As complete novices, we rely on Anita to guide us through our first experience. With her help, we gear up and set off up the snowy slopes. At the beginning, our steps are a little unsteady on the powdery slope, which suddenly seems very steep. Snowshoe hiking is accessible

to everyone and requires no previous experience. 'Walk as normally as possible. The most common mistake to avoid is spreading your legs,' says Anita. Another tip: on steep slopes, put your heel down first and then roll the movement out until your toes touch the ground.

With this advice in mind, we gain confidence. All that remains is to admire

the stunning scenery that surrounds us. It is so captivating that we forget the effort. However, we quickly have to take off our jackets and gloves, something Anita actually encourages us to do: 'When we stop, you will get cold very quickly; keep a layer to add!' She lets us enjoy the peace and quiet of our surroundings, while occasionally pointing out animal tracks or the difference between the trees in the area.

And then we spot smoke rising in the distance. We head in its direction and discover a small spot that Anita's helpers have set up for us: a bench of snow with blankets and a fire await us. The sun slowly disappears behind the mountain. Here, in the heart of nature and far from daily stress, we experience a truly special moment. Anita takes out a wooden board wrapped in foil, a cheese and her grandfather's raclette knife from her bag. That's all she needs to prepare delicious raclette over a wood fire, which she places on a piece of bread. She has not forgotten the essential pickles and white wine.

We speak again only at the bottom of the slope, as we part ways, happy to have shared such a warm, memorable experience together.



## Celebrating our roots



### The Alphorn

In the past it was used to gather livestock and to communicate from one valley to another, but today the Alphorn has become an instrument in its own right! In Nendaz, you can hear it at many events; you can even learn to play it or attend the International Alphorn Festival, which plunges you into a world of folklore and traditions.

### Bisses

Nendaz boasts eight bisses, which represent a unique network of 98 km. Dug out of the ground, cut into or suspended from rock faces between 1435 and 1876, they bear witness to the history of the Nendards and their struggle to combat drought. Although the water of Nendaz has been bottled on a large scale since 1947, it has, for much longer, been diverted via the bisses to irrigate crops. Today, the bisses still serve this primary function of irrigation; six of them have water flowing within their banks every year during the summer months. Situated between 700 and 2,300 metres above sea level, the bisses are a delight for walkers of all ages. The paths running alongside them are popular for leisurely walks because they are traffic free, are relatively flat and are often shady. The bisse du Milieu has two special features: it can be accessed directly from the centre of the resort and it is also accessible in winter on foot or on snowshoes.

### Charming villages

The municipality of Nendaz is unique in that it is made up of seventeen villages and hamlets, spread between the Rhone Valley and the mountains. Apricot orchards, historic mills, old raccards (wooden granaries), breathtaking panoramic views, chapels and churches — each village has its own special character.



### In the Deserter's footsteps

Charles-Frédéric Brun, nicknamed the «Deserter», arrived in Nendaz in the middle of the 19th century. He traded his colourful paintings for meals. He lived as a homeless man in fear of the police, hiding between Nendaz and the Val d'Hérens, until his death in 1871. A thematic footpath re-traces his story along a walk between Haute-Nendaz, Basse-Nendaz and Saclentse.

### Le Nînd'Art

Located in the heart of the village of Haute-Nendaz, the Nînd'Art is a space dedicated to the culture and heritage of Nendaz. Throughout the year, exhibitions and events are held here.



## Our top picks

### Raclette and life in the cowshed

Two activities are organized in a cowshed throughout the winter. The first is an opportunity to visit the famous Hérens cows in their winter quarters and find out about the work of the farmers who feed them, milk them twice a day, look after them and groom them. The second is an opportunity to learn how to prepare the famous Nendaz raclette before enjoying a tasting.

### Village Secrets NEW

Why doesn't the famous saying "Remettre l'église au milieu du village" (Put the church back in the middle of the village) apply to the church in Haute-Nendaz? Did you know that the 'grenier' (attic) was used as a safe by the villagers? A new tool dedicated to the discovery of our cultural and historical heritage has been put in place by the municipality of Nendaz. Designed to spark curiosity, it invites visitors to explore hidden treasures and discover fascinating anecdotes at their own pace. Thanks to Genius Loci, your walks can become a genuine cultural experience. Equipped with your mobile phone, scan the medal markers and learn about the village thanks to information collected from our elders, documented archives or from ancient photos.

# Nendaz in summertime



## Breathtaking scenery

While visiting Nendaz, a few exceptional places stand out for their breathtaking views, peaceful surroundings and stunning natural scenery:

- the Cleuson dam, with its turquoise waters, and higher up, at 2600 metres above sea level, the Lac du Grand Désert, which plunges hikers into an exotic mineral world.
- The Jardin Japonais (Japanese Gardens), so named for its resemblance to a landscaped garden, is actually an entirely natural site and is unique in the region. The meandering stream of water makes it a popular spot for families.
- The Dent de Nendaz, which is relatively easy to access, allows everyone to enjoy the satisfaction of reaching a real summit (2,462 metres). The short hour's ascent is amply rewarded by the incredible panoramic view over the Lac Noir just below, the Alps opposite and the Rhone Valley below.



## Top tip

### Nendaz Trekking

The Nendaz Trekking is an 'all-inclusive' walking tour. Hikers can choose tours of 3 or 4 days, with overnight stays in mountain cabins between Nendaz and Veysonnaz. It is aimed at the average hiker (no technical difficulty) who is physically fit.
