Nendaz Snow Vibes Festival

There's nothing like a fantastic party at 2200 metres above sea level to end the winter season in style. In Tracouet, the waterslide competition open to all in the morning is followed by performances by internationally renowned DJs headed by Ofenbach and Kungs!

A 200m2 dancefloor with palm trees and hot tubs awaits visitors to the Nendaz Snow Vibes Festival. From the top of the Haute-Nendaz gondola, the site is accessible on foot or on skis.

Waterslide

From 10h45 in the morning, the most adventurous can take part in the waterslide competition, while the others cheer them on and enjoy the show. The challenge is to cross a trench of water on skis or snowboard in the most stylish way possible. Prizes are awarded for the best tricks, the most original costumes, and the best wipe outs. Registrations can be made at the tourist information office in Nendaz or on site from 10 o'clock.

Ofenbach and Kungs on the turntables

DJs are taking to the stage from 12 noon. Among them:

- Ofenbach: This Parisian duo, at only 26 years old, is one of the rising stars of the deep house scene, even if their sound is not exclusively electro and calls out to well-known names in rock and folk culture. This can be heard from "Be Mine", which topped the charts worldwide and has racked up over 500 million streams. It was the first of many international successes that would lead the duo to become one of the most listened to French bands in the world! Sixteen times platinum and 10 times gold, their various singles (including "Katchi", "Paradise", "Party", "Rock it") have allowed them to tour the world. Their latest track 'Wasted Love' immediately topped the European and American charts.
- Kungs: Frenchman Kungs, whose real name is Valentin Brunel, released "This Girl" in 2016. He was only 19 years old at the time and it was already his first big hit: it reached number 1 in the European charts and its video was viewed 460 million times on Youtube! The album that followed, "Layers", sold over half a million copies and went platinum. It earned him an NRJ Music Award in 2017 as well as a Victoire de la Musique. During the confinement, Kungs recorded the single "Never Going Home", which was repeatedly broadcast on mainstream radio stations. In mid-March 2022, he is releasing his latest album "Club Azur", of which he is sure to unveil some new tracks in Nendaz!

The après-ski is continuing at The Gallery bar where the French DJ, producer and Tik toker Yaniss, who has more than 580,000 subscribers on his favourite social network, is performing. His remixes are regularly broadcast on NRJ and Fun Radio. Other events and concerts are also taking place at the Edelweiss and the Cactus.

Access to the concerts on the slopes is free on presentation of a lift pass. All lift pass holders can therefore attend the show free of charge. Other guests can simply buy a return gondola ticket. These and VIP packages are available online.
