The area's historic mountain water irrigation channels, called "bisses", form a remarkable network of waterside paths that sometimes wind through charming villages and at other times cling to the mountainside. Children and adults alike love these easy walks, from spring through autumn.

Bisse du Milieu

This short water channel is easily accessible to all

Bisse Vieux

A peaceful walk along the water's edge through the heart of the forest

Bisse de Chervé

The highest bisse in Nendaz, set in an incredible alpine landscape.

Bisse de Baar

A beautiful bisse passing through dry prairies and apricot orchards

Bisse d'en Bas

A cool, shady walk through a wild natural setting

Bisse de Salins

An impressive bisse dating back to the Middle Ages

Bisse de Saxon

The longest bisse in the Valais, with a footpath stretching 32 kilometres

Guided Walk along a Bisse

From June to October, there's nothing better than walking along one of Nendaz's eight bisses (historic irrigation channels). Connect with nature and take in the stunning panorama as a passionate local guide shares the stories and cultural treasures of Nendaz's past.

Hike & Raclette Tasting

Enjoy an unforgettable evening immersed in nature, combining outdoor adventure and culinary delights. After a short hike through the forest, savour a traditional raclette cooked over a wood fire.

Alphorn Experience

Try your hand at playing the Alphorn, a traditional Swiss instrument—and with a bit of luck, you might be blowing your first notes.

Nendaz Trekking

Set off from Veysonnaz and hike through the Nendaz Valley to Nendaz at your own pace. Spend your nights in welcoming mountain huts nestled in idyllic settings surrounded by the majestic landscapes between these two destinations. This is a self-guided tour, with the option to include a guide if you wish.

Mont-Fort Viewpoint & Zipline

In winter and summer, take a cableway ride to our iconic peak, the Mont-Fort at 3,330 m—the highest mountain in the 4 Vallées. Breathe in the crisp air at the summit, and soak up the breathtaking view. For the more adventurous, fly over the Tortin glacier to the Col des Gentianes on the Mont-Fort zipline!

Rando'Miam

Rando'Miam invites you to experience the mountains in a truly unique way. Set off on a leisurely walk through picturesque alpine scenery, with three gourmet stops along the route. Available in spring, summer and autumn, each edition captures the essence of the season and highlights the rich flavours of regional specialties. In autumn, the walk places a special focus on local game.




